- This is carried out in small groups containing 4-6 children.
- Some of the children with in the group will be communication role models, this is to help support the other children, they will role model good language, turn taking and interactions.
- The session will run over 6 weeks with the same group of children using a range of different fun activities and recourses.
- The sessions are structured using visual supports and all sessions follow the same routine.
