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What is a communication group

- A communication group is an intervention to help support children's social interaction, confidence and language skills.
- This is carried out in small groups containing 4-6 children.
- Some of the children within the group will be communication role models, this is to help support the other children, they will role model good language, turn taking and interactions.
- The session will run over 6 weeks with the same group of children using a range of different fun activities and resources.
- The sessions are structured using visual supports and all sessions follow the same routine.

- We are carrying out communication groups to help boost children's personal, social and emotional development as well as their communication and language development.
- Through this we hope to see progression with in all prime areas of development.
