What is Stories for Talking?

Stories for talking is a very structured language programme to support early language development for all children. It teaches a range of language development skills through stories and themes. This is based on three different levels of teaching:

- Vocabulary
- Sentence building
- Narrative Skills

All children in the Early Years will benefit this and also addresses children who are learning English as an additional language or those with speech, language and communication difficulties.

How often does this get carried out?

Depending on your child's level of language and understanding, they will be placed into a group of a maximum of 6 children to carry out this programme and appropriate language will be used throughout to meet each individual child's level and need. This will be carried out over 6 weeks using the same story for the children to become familiar with object names, understanding and identifying concepts. Similar objects/ activities will be placed around the environment to familiarise children with them and for them to begin understand what these are and strengthen their word level vocabulary.

After each session you will be informed of your child's progress.
